Ohio's Best Rx

Offers drug assistance via a Discount Card program. No cost to apply or enroll. Eligible to Ohio residents who have no prescription drug insurance coverage and are either over age 60, or under age 60 with no prescription drug insurance coverage and income under 300% of the Federal poverty level.

Free statewide prescription assistance through a Discount Card program for all Ohio residents. Can be used to supplement most health insurance plans including Health Savings Accounts (HSA) and high deductible plans. Can also be used as a Medicare Part D supplement by providing discounts on non-covered drugs.
